You can purchase your animal licence by any of the following options:

- Mail your application form along with a cheque made to the Town of Kapuskasing.
- Leave your payment with your application form in the Civic Centre after hours drop box located at the front entrance of the Municipal building (located at 88 Riverside Drive).
- Credit Card purchase - Call the Town's reception with your animal information and credit card information at 705-335-2341

\*When your payment has been completed, the animal tag(s) will be mailed to the address you provided. A completed Animal Licence Application Form must be submitted with your payment when purchasing a licence. All Animal Licence Rates include taxes.
